**Year 6 Summer Term Newsletter**

Whilst the beautifully warm, sunny start to the new term seems to have subsided temporarily, it is with optimism that I anticipate its return to help make your child's final term at Kingsfleet a truly enjoyable one.

Attached, you will find a **Curriculum Map** with a brief outline of the work we will be covering this term. I hope you find this useful as you discuss school life with your child.

Please be advised of the following points:-

- **P.E. lessons** will take place on an ad-hoc basis, weather-dependent, with regular cricket sessions on **Thursday mornings**. Please, therefore, ensure that your child has both indoor and outdoor kits in school every day; children will be expected to fully participate unless they have a note to excuse them.
  - Indoor kit: white school T-shirt, red shorts and plimsolls.
  - Outdoor kit: tracksuit or similar and trainers.
  - A change of socks is very important.
- *Please, please, please* ensure that all items of clothing are **named**, since “without a name, they're all the same!”
- Children will continue to receive **maths and English homework** every **Friday** – to be returned the following Friday – up until SATs, and again after half term.
- Whilst no new **spellings** will be set, the correct spelling of most of the Y5/6 words is required in order to achieve Expected Standard in children's writing. Please, therefore, continue to help your child to learn those yet to be ticked off in their reading records.
- It is **hugely beneficial** to your child if you are able to hear them **read regularly** at home. Please record, as appropriate, in their reading record.
- As you are already aware, **SATs week** is w/c: **Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2018**. It is extremely important that your child attends school this week and arrives promptly.

- The SATs timetable is as follows:  
Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> May: Grammar and Punctuation and Spelling Tests  
Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> May: English Reading  
Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> May: Maths Arithmetic and Maths Reasoning  
Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> May: Maths Reasoning
