### School Dinners and morning snack.

Parents/Carers of children currently in Year 2, please be aware that when your child joins Year 3 in September they will no longer be eligible for universal free school meals. If you think you may be eligible for free school meals you can apply online at

The cost of a meal is £2.30. Dinner money can be paid online or in a named and sealed envelope placed in their class box on a Monday.

Another change for the children as they move into Key Stage is that they are no longer part of the free fruit and veg scheme. This will mean that they will not be provided with snack of fruit/veg at morning break. They are of course welcome to bring a snack from home and we encourage a healthy snack choice - no sweets or chocolate bars please.

Please remember that Kingsfleet is a 'no nuts' school when sending snacks or preparing a packed lunch.

### **Key Stage 2 SATs results**

We are required by Suffolk County to submit end of year data for Early Years, Year 2 and Year 6. The end of Key Stage 2 data comes from SATs taken by the children in Year 6, the data from Early Years and Year 2 is from teacher assessment.

The tests taken by the year 6 children are externally marked and the results are as follows;  
Reading 93% expected or above  
Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar 93% expected or above  
Maths 74% expected or above

Once verified all data will be published to parents in the autumn term.
