## **Enterprise Afternoon - Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018 and Upper Key Stage 2 Play Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

As part of the PSHEE curriculum, Kingsfleet pupils are taking on the challenge to be entrepreneurial. All phases have been asked to devise ways of showcasing their understanding of enterprise by planning ways to make money which will be donated to charity. Small budgets have been used which will be repaid from monies raised to calculate profit and children will be able to see how successful they have been with their efforts. The charity has been chosen by the upper Key Stage 2 children and is the **Ben Ramsay Memorial Fund** which is raising money to screen young adults for Adult Death Syndrome working with the charity **CRY** (Cardiac Risk in the Young). Ben Ramsay attended local Felixstowe schools and sadly died from this syndrome last summer at the age of 22. Mrs Rayner and Mrs Clarke have both previously worked with Ben's mum at Fairfield Infant School.

**Years 5 and 6** have been busy practising a play, *The Wind in the Willows* to perform. They have made scenery, designed programmes and tickets and are excited about performing to an audience. Due to limited space in the hall, tickets have been firstly on sale to parents of children from these classes but from 6<sup>th</sup> July any spare can be purchased from the school office for £1.

**Years 3 and 4** have designed cards to sell and have made some woven coasters. Their creations will be for sale on the Enterprise Afternoon – Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July. Children will be in the hall from 2:45 and invite you to come and purchase one or two of their products. All products will be less than £2. Additionally they are holding a competition to win £10. Squares on a treasure map can be purchased for £1 each and the winner will be notified through their contact child the following week. Squares are now on sale – so send your £1 in in a named envelope with your child and they will be able to choose a square by visiting the Year 4 classroom during registration times. Any unsold squares will be available for you to purchase at the Enterprise Afternoon.

**Key Stage 1 and EYFS** are baking! Biscuits and cakes will be on sale for a small amount on the Enterprise Afternoon.

The children always enjoy raising money to support a worthy cause and we trust that you will support their efforts to make this a successful end to their enterprises.
