Please conceal your child's name and year group on the base of your design; you may also wish to give your creation a title. Some examples of previous competition entries are given overleaf - these were made for a different theme.

Assistance from other family members is welcomed and therefore all entries will be judged together, with no separate categories determined by age group. Prizes will be awarded to the winning children.

There is no limit to the number of eggs that may be submitted by each child. A £1 entry fee will apply, to be brought to school with your creation, which will be donated to St Elizabeth Hospice.

Competition entries need to be brought into your child's classroom on the morning of **Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2018**. They will be judged and exhibited in the hall after school on the same day and you are all most welcome to come and celebrate others' artistic prowess!

Please note: for health and safety reasons, all entries will be disposed of on **Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> April**. Therefore, if you wish to salvage your design, please do so **before 4:00pm on Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> April**.
