Just a few reminders...

Cycling/ Scooting to school

Once children arrive at school they should dismount and push their bike or scooter into the Bike Shelter. Bikes and scooters are not to be ridden on the playground.

When storing bikes and scooters in the Bike Shelter, please ensure that they do not block the emergency exit gate from Old Felixstowe Nursery as this must be clear at all times.

Jewellery in school

For health and safety reasons jewellery is not allowed in school, apart from stud-type sleeper earrings for pierced ears. We have found that children are bringing/ wearing items that are valuable to them and there is a risk that they may get lost.

If your child wears stud earrings, please remember that s/he must be able to remove them without help for PE lessons or, alternatively, bring in micro-tape to protect the earrings.



Play Equipment Reminder

Children are not allowed to go on the play equipment or play on the field before school starts or at the end of the school day – this is due to insurance restrictions.

Toys in School

Children enjoy bringing their belongings into school to show their class teacher or friends; however we asked that items from home, such as toys are only brought in when there is a written request from the teacher as part of a sharing activity or in connection with a topic.

Names in belongings

Please could you ensure that all items of clothes and belongings are named.



Lost Property

Lost property will be sorted at the end of every half term and all named items will be returned to the children.

Any unclaimed items will be given to the KSA second hand uniform shop or a local charity.

PE Kit

As P.E. is part of the National Curriculum it is essential that all children take part. Therefore I would be grateful if you could ensure that the correct kit is provided.

Below is a list of the recommended items of clothing:

- Indoor – white school t-shirt, red shorts, plimsolls
- Outdoor-tracksuit or similar, trainers

Please ensure that both P.E. Kits are in school on Mondays ready for the week ahead.



Parking

The school has a private car park for staff and visitors. There are also spaces allocated to Old Felixstowe Nursery for use by their staff.

Please do not use the car park other than when responding to a call from the school regarding the health of your child or if you have been given a parking permit from the main office.

Elmcroft Lane is not part of school property and therefore I appreciate that the school can only request that in the interests of child safety Parents and Carers do not park here.

If however you do choose to park on Elmcroft Lane please take great care when manouvering your vehicle as already this term a child's safety has been put at risk.

Water Bottles

One of the main ways in which we can make sure that the conditions for learning are right is to make water available to children at all times.

Water is provided for the children in Miss Chatts's class (EYFS) , however all other year groups are encouraged to bring in water bottles.

We recommend bottles that have pull up mouth pieces, as there are no lids to get lost and it reduces the amount of spillage should the bottles be knocked...and of course are clearly named.



Pedestrian Access

The vehicle access into the staff car park is also used by the residents at the end of Elmcroft Lane and there is the risk of moving vehicles which pose a safety risk.

We therefore advise all pedestrians to use the main route into school and follow the marked path which takes you in front of the kitchen into the playground.
