Year Five and Six Autumn term trips

All children will need a **packed lunch** and a **water bottle**. They may also bring a snack for break time.

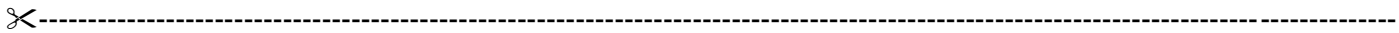
If your child requires a **travel pill** for the journey, please ensure this is taken in plenty of time. Any pills for the return journey must be in a named envelope and given to the class teacher.
