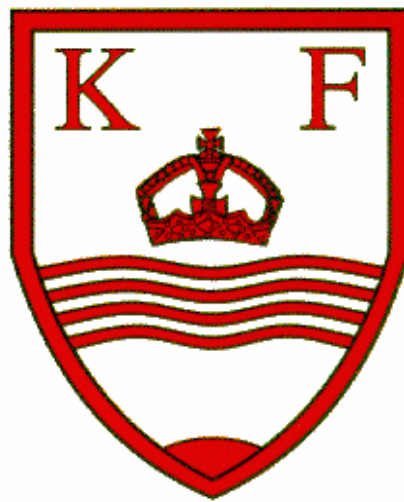

Agreement for School

Our aim is to develop in our children a desire for education, so that they will have a secure foundation in life skills and in learning

The school will:

- provide your child with a high standard of education through a broad, balanced and stimulating curriculum.

- teach your child to develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values and age
- welcome you into the life of school and provide information to you about school, including meetings, activities and events
- regularly meet with you to communicate the progress of your child, celebrating their strengths and explaining how we can support their development
