

Pupil Premium Expenditure and impact report 2012/13

For the academic year 2012/13, Kingsfleet received £16,094 in Pupil Premium funding. This was used for the following:-

- To provide additional teaching assistant support for those with Special Educational Needs.
- To provide intervention programmes for underachieving children, particularly targeting those with additional speech and language needs.
- To provide a nurture group that offers a short term, focussed, intervention strategy - addressing barriers to learning arising from social/emotional and or behavioural difficulties, in an inclusive, supportive manner.
- To purchase Education City e-learning resource to support teaching and learning.
- To enable four key personnel to attend ELKLAN training - enabling them to be more effective in their support of children with speech, language communication needs. This will also lead to the school gaining Communication Friendly status.
